Dear Friends and Family:

AYABA, a program of the Ascent Funding Organization (a 501C3 non-profit) comprised of student volunteers from across the metropolitan area, have teamed up with players from the *Hewlett High School Lacrosse* program to create the *BulldogGoals4Autism* and *BulldogSaves4Autism* Program.

We are reaching out to you because you might be in a position to help further the "Goals & Saves" mission to:

- (1) *To promote awareness, tolerance and acceptance for children impacted by autism;*
- (2) *Play a part in allowing children with autism to reach their full potential by soliciting (a) additional student volunteers and/or (b) straight donations or pledges tied into goals scored and saves made by the 2011 Hewlett High School Varsity LAX Team, the funds ultimately being used for the educational and social skill enhancement of children with autism; and*
- (3) *Achieve AYABA's & the Hewlett student volunteer's mutual "goal" of raising at least (a) \$25,000 for local autism programs and (b) \$10,000 for the community minded Hewlett Lacrosse Parents Association and the entire Hewlett LAX Program.*

100% of the proceeds from the Ascent Funding Organization's total share will be distributed in the form of \$2,000 grants to each of the *Nassau-Suffolk Autism Society of America (NSASA)* and the *Kids in Special Services (KISS) Program of the Mid Island Y*, with the balance to the *Ascent School for Autism*.

All volunteers receive (a) a Letter of Recognition for their college application and/or job resume, (b) an executive title and (c) a BulldogGoals4Autism T-Shirt. The "seniority" of an executive title is tied into to the amount of pledges/donations a student raises, the amount of volunteers secured and/or the amount of "sweat equity" contributed on behalf of BulldogGoals4Autism.
